IN THE MATTER OF ORDER NO.21/2018-19 DATED 28.09.2018 REGARDING ECONOMIC REGULATION OF AERONAUTICAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY AIRPORT OPERATORS/INDEPENDENT SERVICE PROVIDERS OF CARGO FACILITY, GROUND HANDLING AND SUPPLY OF FUEL TO THE AIRCRAFT-INTERIM ARRANGEMENT TO CONTINUE THE LEVY OF EXISTINING TRAIFFS BEYOND 31.03.2019 FOR THE RELEVANT CONTROL PERIOD

The Airports Economic Regulatory Authority (AERA), in exercise of powers conferred on them by section 13(1) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, vide Order No.48/2018-19 dated 25/03/2019 has extended the existing tariff as on 31.03.2019 for a further period of six months w.e.f. 1.04.2019 to 30.09.2019 to avoid any regulatory vacuum in respect of the tariffs being levied by the regulated entities. A copy of the above Order is enclosed.

2. These charges shall come into effect on 01st April, 2019 in the manner prescribed by AERA.

2. The Authority is in process of scrutinizing the MYTP/ATP submission received from various Airport Operators/Independent Service Providers viz. Cargo Operations, Ground Handling Agencies and Into Plane Service Providers and the determination process is likely to take some time. Further many ISPs have not submitted their ATPs for 4th and 5th tariff years. In addition to this in respect of ISPs at SI.No. 21 to 25, AAI has given extension of contract upto 30.06.2019. In respect of ISP at SI. No. 26, contract with AAI is valid upto 31.05.2019. Hence, the Authority has decided that the Airport Operators/ Independent Services Providers at List A (SI.No. 1 to 4) and B (SI. No. 5 to 20, 27 to 35) above, may be allowed to continue the levy of the tariffs existing as on 31.03.2019 for a period of six months w.e.f. 01.04.2019 to 30.09.2019 or till determination of tariffs for the first/second/third (as applicable) control period, whichever is earlier. ISPs at SI.No. 21 to 25 may be allowed to continue levy of existing tariff upto 30.06.2019. ISP at SI.No. 26 may be allowed to continue levy of existing tariff upto 31.05.2019.

ORDER

In view of the above, to avoid any regulatory vacuum in respect of the tariffs being levied by the regulated entities, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1) of the Airport Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 hereby orders that:-

- (i) The Airport Operators/ Independent Service Providers as per list A and B (SI. No. 1 to 20, 27 to 35) as above are allowed to continue levy of tariffs existing as on 31.03.2019, for a further period of six months w.e.f. 01.04.2019 to 30.09.2019 or till determination of tariffs for the First/Second/Third Control Period (as applicable) whichever is earlier. Remaining ISPs at SI.No. 21 to 25 are allowed to continue levy of existing tariff as on 31.03.2019 upto 30.06.2019. ISP at SI.No. 26 is allowed to continue levy of existing tariff as on 31.03.2019 upto 31.05.2019 or till determination of tariff whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators may ensure timely submission of proposals by Independent Service Providers at the respective major airports and also ensure compliance of the Order.
