SUBJECT: REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTOMATIC DEPENDENT SURVEILLANCE-BROADCAST (ADS-B) AUTHORIZATION

1. INTRODUCTION

Indian operators must obtain DGCA approval for flight operations in airspace requiring the use of ADS-B prior to conducting flight operations.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

No person shall operate Indian registered aircraft using ADS-B for flight operations unless:

- 2.1 The operator and the operator's aircraft comply with the requirements of this CAR, applicable DGCA guidance, and applicable circulars;
- 2.2 The operator obtains ADS-B approval from the DGCA; and
- 2.3 The operator's operations specifications authorize the use of ADS-B for flight operations.

3. AIRWORTHINESS AND OPERATIONAL APPROVAL

Airworthiness and operational approval of ADS-B will be in accordance with Operations Circular 17 of 2014

4. **FEES -** Fees for ADS- B authorization on first aircraft type with the operator shall be Rupees ten Thousand only.
