- All the calculations of the validity, total flying, flying in preceding 12 months/ 6 months is based on the date of application in DGCA and applicant shall possess all the requisite documents including medical, DGCA written exam results, RTR(A) on the date of submission of papers in DGCA, else application would be summarily rejected.
- 4. In case of foreign national, enclose nationality certificate OR attested copy of passport.

- 6. Log book shall be maintained as per rule 67 and there shall be no cuttings.
